Schedule of the journées

Friday, June the 13rd – institutional meetings and continental sand dunes

10:00 am: Meeting with Mayor of Autun, the Communal Museum Jacques de la Comble, the SHNA and SEF within the Museum of Autun.

12:00 am: Departure to the Sables de Pontseille (continental fossil sand dunes) (animation by the CEN Bourgogne) (<u>max. 35 attendees</u>) – 1h from Autun, on the road between Châlons and Mâcon (South to Tournus).

Saturday, June the 14th – Morvan massif typical forests

9:00 am: Meeting point in Autun, Place du Champ de Mars at the kiosk, or 9:30 am at the car park on the route des Cloix just after the crossing with the D120.

Lunch (each participant takes its own meal): pique-nique at the bergerie de Montmain at 12:30 am.

Departure at 2pm to another forest biotope nearby (Cascade de Brisecou or Croix de la Libération).

Banquet in Autun, 7 pm at the Lutrin Restaurant (place Saint-Louis) besides the Cathedral.

Option. Study of aquatic insects (animation: Guillaume Leraut)

Meeting point 1, 2:30 pm at the corner of the Rue des Ragots, car park before the small bridge Meeting point 2, 4:30 pm at the car park of the "Temple de Janus" in Autun.

Sunday, June the 15th – Limestone cliffs and grasslands

Saint-Jean-de-Vaux (Barizey) close to the famous wineyards of Beaune and Santenay! (animated by the CEN Bourgogne and the SHNA)

Meeting point: at 9:00 am in Autun, Place du Champ de Mars at the kiosque, or the Church of St. Jean-de-Vaux at 10:00 am.

Option for participants who prefer staying in the vicinity of Autun. Meeting at 10:00 am at the Champ de Mars Kiosque; visit of the Planoise Forest near the Croix de la Libération (dry oaks forest) before lunch.

Some typical biotopes

Sables de Pont-Seille

Fossil continental sand dunes (former edges of the Sa $\hat{}$ one River) – last S.E.F. prospections in year 1999



Planoise forest - Pond of the Etang des Cloix and bergerie of Montmain, Croix de la Libération, Brisecou Cascade

A biotope emblematic of the Morvan forests (altitude 1800 ft) with many wetlands and streams. The woods are of oaks, beeches, birches and heaths on granite soil.



Confluence of the Ternin and Arroux rivers (Loire basin – altitude 900 ft.)

Interesting biotope for benthic and riparian insects; in recent years, were have identified around thirty species of Trichoptera, around ten of Plecoptera, and the Coleoptera fauna is likely diverse.



Cliffs of Couches

Dry limestone grasslands and oaks shrublands rich in Butterflies and Burnets.
